
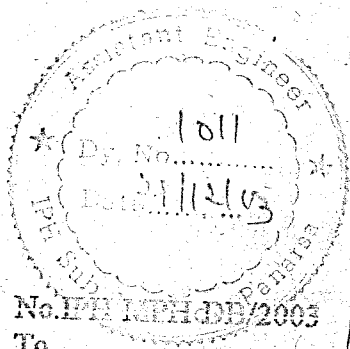

Drying up of water sources due to construction of Lurgi
HEP.

Reference:-

Your office letter No. 872-75 dated 9-9-2003.

Sir,

In response to your office letter under reference, it is submitted that the subject cited estimate has been framed exclusively for the discharge affected due to construction of Lurgi Hydel Project. It will not be genuine and justified to deprive of the beneficiaries/inhabitants of that area of the facilities already being availed by them today and in the near future in case of drinking water supply.

This estimate has been prepared keeping in view the actual loss to the beneficiaries. The lump sum item rates for few items have been taken into consideration keeping in view the prevailing market rates and rates quoted by the contractors in the tenders recently called, for works being executed by department. If there is any doubt/ambiguity regarding some specific items, analysed rates for the same can be furnished. It is worth mentioning that it will not be possible to commission and to run any lift water supply scheme without supply of power. So it is obligatory on the part of HPSEB to provide funds for supply of power or otherwise supply power free of cost. The estimate for providing supply of power will be supplied to your office after obtaining the

Sanction from the HPSEB authorities. The funds for supply of power may please also be made available to the department on this account.

From the past experience i.e. C/O of BSL project, it has been observed that the dried up sources did not revive after commissioning of the project. Instead in the post construction period, it had added more to the miseries of inhabitants. The inhabitants of the area are till today struggling for their legitimate rights.

The estimate has been framed keeping in view the legitimate genuine, human, and justified demand of the beneficiaries. The lowest possible genuine and justified rates have been taken for framing the estimate. It will not be proper to reduce the amount.


It is therefore requested that the estimate be approved and funds for the execution of scheme be made available at the earliest possible please.

Drying up of water sources due to
construction of Lanji Hydro Electric
Project.

This is regarding the effect of
construction of Lanji Project on the water supply and
traditional sources in G.P. Bhatwari, G.P. Aut, G.P. Bandhi
and Motadhar.

In this regard, it is intimated that
construction of Lanji Hydro Project is being carried out
by H.P.S.B. authority. The tunnelling work for diversion of
traffic tunnel, water diversion tunnel and exit tunnel
is being done by the project authority. Due to construction
activities, especially huge tunnelling work, nearly 1113
water supply schemes and a number of traditional sources on
the hill slope have been adversely affected.

The worst affected area are village Jalle,
Khimi, Rudu, Kashma, Devkhan, Bhatwari, Mangri, Khaurada, Thalou,
Saja, Sansoi, Panu, Taper and Beni Banji. Public of these
areas has also made an agitation against the project authority
for their grievances.

A detailed estimate on the above cited
subject amounting to Rs. 2.65 crore in triplicate has
already been submitted to the Director (Planning) HPSEB Mandi
(H.P.) vide Superintending Engineer, I.A.P.H. Circle, Sundernagar
office letter No. 6579-23 dated 7.8.2003. But no action
in this regard has been taken so far by the HPSEB authority.

At present keeping in view the grievances,
of the public, a departmental truck has been deployed for
supplying water to the affected area i.e. Village Jalle,
Khimi, Devkhan, Beni Banji etc. It is further submitted that
this department has no funds available for supplying water
with departmental truck to the above affected villages and
it has become difficult for the department to deploy
departmental truck continuously for more time.

It is therefore requested that keeping in
view the grievances of the public and in order to avoid

any objection of the public of the affected area, the project authority may please be asked to delay the water tanker to these villages till some alternative arrangement is made or the problem is solved permanently.
